

Regular Meeting:

The Council for the City of Pendergrass met at the Pendergrass City Hall on Tuesday, March 30, 2021 at 9:00am for the monthly meeting of March. Those present were Mayor Monk Tolbert; Council members Harlan Robinson, Sabrina Guevara and Willie Pittmon; City Clerk Renee Martinez; City Attorney standing in for Tom McCormack--Paula Stewart. Nathan Pruitt absent. Mayor Tolbert opened with an invocation.

The minutes of the February meeting were approved as presented. Motion to accept the minutes made by Harlan Robinson; seconded by Willie Pittmon.

Street Report

The streets department started cutting grass two weeks ago. They've used a bobcat on the field in front of the liquor store to clear the land. That piece of land would be good for events. We've contacted TruGreen to set up a weed program for our parks and around city hall.

New Business

- B. First reading of Ordinance to adopt the streets in the Seasons of Pendergrass subdivision. Willie Pittmon asks what the city will do about on street parking. Rob Russell says it's something the council needs to address.

Old Business

- A. Vote on Resolution to increase Waste Pro fee for garbage collection. Attorney Paula Stewart states that if the city decides to vote against this, Waste Pro can pursue damages. Mayor Tolbert asks for a motion to approve the resolution- Harlan Robinson makes a motion; seconded by Sabrina Guevara. The increase will begin after May 1, 2021.

Public Input

Harlan Robinson asks if the City Hall parking lot will be resurfaced. Rob Russell says the city hasn't gotten to it yet. Cedar Dr. needed to be resurfaced first.

Nick Gieman asks about ATVs and golf carts in the subdivisions, covenants in the subdivisions, and the speed limits. There was a discussion about the law on the subject.

Donovan Jones asks what the HOAs can do about on street parking until the city takes over the streets. Rob suggests sending a letter with the section of the covenant that states the rules on street parking.
