RESOLUTION NUMBER: 2021 – 03 - 001

A RESOLUTION TO ALLOW FOR A PRICE INCREASE IN THE WASTE DISPOSAL AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY'S WASTE PROVIDER, TO REPEAL CONFLICTING RESOLUTIONS; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Section I.

WHEREAS, by Ordinance, the City of Pendergrass is vested with contracting for one Service Provider for the collection of refuse and waste materials the City of Pendergrass; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council may from time to time modify the fees charged for residential and commercial garbage services and establish new fees by resolution;

WHEREAS, each resident and each commercial establishment shall be entitled to receive such garbage collection service as provided upon payment to the City contracted waste collection provider a garbage collection fee; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have received notice from Waste Pro, the City's contracted waste collector, pursuant to the terms of an Agreement signed by the City of Pendergrass and Waste Pro in 2017, of a request to increase the garbage collection rates in order to keep up with the increase in cost of performing the same; and

WHEREAS, this contract allows for increases in fees to City Residents for this service, pursuant to annual combined CPI calculations from the Georgia Department of Labor and changes in the costs of disposal resulting from House Bill 385, which passed in 2018, and landfill increased costs for disposal; and

WHEREAS, the CPI for the period December 2019 to December 2020 shows an increase of 4.2%, which equates to a .58 cent increase in the rate for this portion of the calculation; and

WHEREAS, the disposal rate per ton in 2017 was \$28.49 per ton. In 2021 it has increased 22.8%, to \$35.00 per ton, which equates to an increase of \$1.14 for the disposal part of the calculation.

Section II.

THEREFORE, the total price adjustment granted for this service provider shall be \$1.72 per home.


Section III.

Resolutions, or parts of Resolutions that conflict with the terms of this Resolution are hereby repealed.


