The Council for the City of Pendergrass met at the Pendergrass Civic Center on Tuesday, September 28, 2021 at 7:00pm for the monthly meeting of September. Those present were Mayor Monk Tolbert; Council members Harlan Robinson and Nathan Pruitt; City Clerk Renee Martinez; City Attorney Paula Stewart. Councilman Pruitt opened with an invocation.

Street Report

Grass growth is slowing down. We are starting to decorate for Christmas and are planning pictures with Santa. Dates will be the first and second Friday in December.

Paula Stewart states that with two council members and the Mayor, we have a quorum.

New Business

- Street signs have been ordered. We've ordered new posts for the signs and are waiting for those to come in.
- First reading of Ordinance to set the speed limits for the streets in The Seasons of Pendergrass Subdivision-- Rob Russell goes over the ordinance to set the speed limit to 25mph.
- Discuss Halloween/Christmas—Halloween will be on a Sunday. Pendergrass encourages citizens to trick or treat on Sunday night. We'll have a police presence out that night for safety. The first and second Friday of December we'll have pictures with Santa. Rob Russell discusses speed limits in the subdivisions and community events. HOA will need to submit an application for road closures for events. Nathan Pruitt asks if the city will do anything for Halloween. Rob Russell says not this year.
- 2010 to 2020 census the City of Pendergrass grew 400%. We went from 422 people to 1,692 people. Per square foot value of property grew tremendously


Old Business
